HERE'S A SAMPLE ON HOW TO COMPUTE YOUR WATER CONSUMPTION

Consumption for the month: **15 cum**

0 – 10 cum (10 cum @ 212.00) = P 212.00

11 – 20 cum (5 cum @ 23.05) = P 115.25

Volume consumed: 15 cum = P 327.25

HERE'S A SAMPLE ON HOW TO COMPUTE YOUR WATER CONSUMPTION

Consumption for the month: **30 cum**

0 – 10 cum(10 cum @ 212.00)	= P 212.00
11 – 20 cum(10 cum @ 23.05)	= P 230.50
21 – 30 cum(10 cum @ 26.65)	= <u>P 266.50</u>

Volume consumed: 30 cum = P 709.00

HOW TO DETECT LEAK



Leakage on our water line can be very costly. Here are simple tips to save you from unexpected increase of water bill:



1. MONITOR READING CONSUMPTION REGULARLY.



Check the black digits in your water meter from time to time. The black digits indicate your amount of consumption. If the numbers are much higher than the reading noted in your recent bill, consider if there has been an increase of number of people in your house during the period covered. If not, check lines for undetected leaks.




2. CHECK BUILT-IN LEAK INDICATOR (RED TRIANGULAR DISC)

Turn-off all faucets. If the triangular disc in your water meter is spinning, then it is likely you have leakage in your line. Immediately contact a plumber to detect and repair your plumbing connections.



Save Water

-  Check faucets, pipe joints and flush bowls for drips and leaks.
 -  Turn off faucets when not in use. Do not let water run while brushing your teeth or soaping your hands, or scrubbing dishes and pots.
 -  Use water efficient toilets. Use only half-flush for urine. Do not use toilet as waste basket to avoid clogging.
 -  Take shorter showers - five (5) minutes or less is best.
 -  Water your yard and outdoor plants early or late in the day to reduce evaporation.
 -  Immediately repair leaks once detected or call GSCWD hotline nos. 552-3824 / 301-3835.
 -  Re-use or Recycle water.
